

LONG COMMENT: Fact Sheet



You write a comment – a short one or a longer one – under a post on the internet. You write it to share what you think.

A task for writing a long comment can look like this:

This tells you about the **situation** you are in.

Read this part carefully.
This is the **message** you are answering.

This tells you **what** you should write.

These **bullet points** tell you what you should write about.

You see Daniel's message online. You decide to leave a **comment**.

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Hi guys,

I want to do a movie night with my friends. What do I need for a great evening? Do you have any tips for me?

These are the question you have to **answer**.

In your **comment** on Daniel's message, you should:

- describe an ideal movie night
- suggest a film or TV show
- say what kind of films or TV shows you enjoy

Write around **120–140 words**.

This tells you **how many words** you should write.



Look at this model text. It shows you all the features of a long comment.

Opening

I love movie nights! Here's what I do:

For a great evening with movies, it's a good idea to **invite four or five friends**. Then talk about what you want to watch, eat and drink. Everyone should **bring some snacks** and soft drinks they like. When each of you has found a **comfy space to sit**, the magic can begin!

As **your** first movie, **you** should watch KPop Demon Hunters. It's an animated fantasy movie full of great music and funny scenes, but also lots of action and emotion. **You** won't be disappointed!

I generally like watching action movies with cool stunts and big explosions. **I love** watching the hero fighting the bad guys, winning and getting away in the end.

I hope I could help you. **Will you tell us how your movie night went?**

Make sure you write an **answer** to the post.

Talk directly to your reader as much as you can.

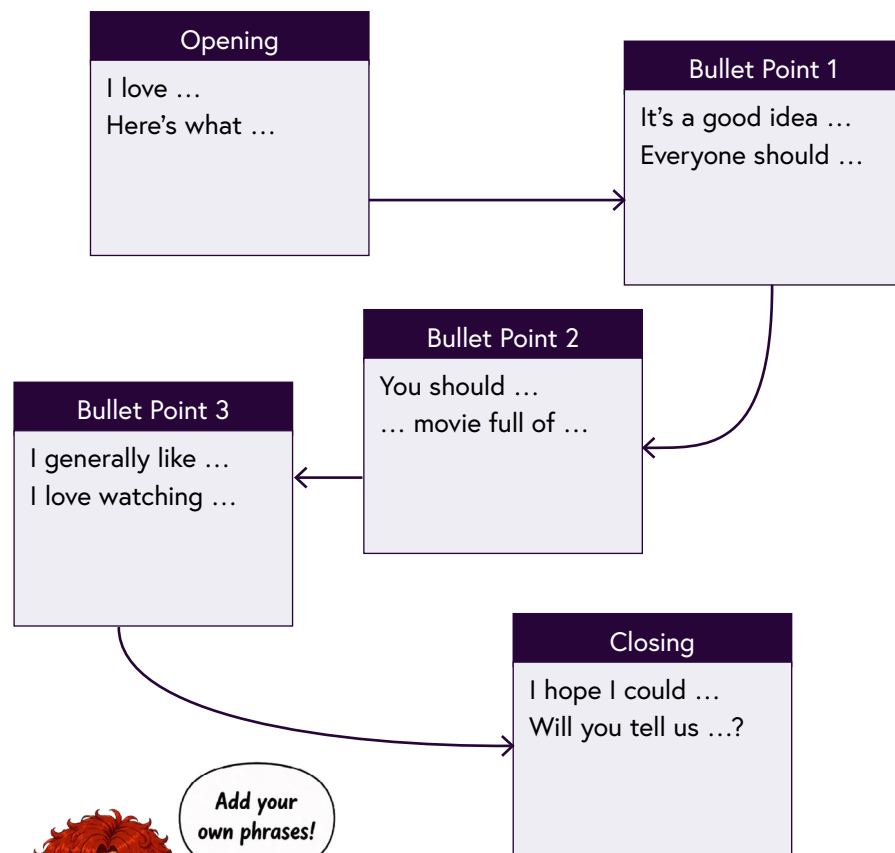
Give **your opinion** on the topic.
